## About Ahmednagar City

Ahmednagar was established as the capital of Ahmedshaha by Ahmad Nizamshah in 1494. It is located in the central part of Maharashtra on Balaghat / Ahmednagar plateau. The famous book “The Discovery of India” was written by India’s first Prime Minister Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru at Ahmednagar, when he was detained by the British in 1942. Ahmednagar is the head quarter of Ahmednagar district. The city is an important military centre which has ACC&S, MIRC, CQAV, BTR, and VRDE & Tank Museum. The famous religious places, Shirdi (83 Km.) and Shanishingnapur (40 Km.) are located in the district. The famous social worker Mr. Anna Hazare resides at Ralegan Siddhi, which is 45 Km. away from Ahmednagar while Mr. Popatrao Pawar, alumni of our college from the city. In 1945 late Padmashree Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil established the first successful co-operative sugar factory at Pravaranagar in Ahmednagar district. Kalsubai, the highest mountain peak in Maharashtra (1646 mts.) is located in the district.

## About the Institution

Ahmednagar Jilha Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj, the leading educational institution in the district was established in 1918 with the inspiration of Chhatrapati Rajarshi Shau Maharaj of Kolhapur and he generously supported the institution, as a tribute to his father Karveer Hutatma Chhatrapati Chouthe Shivaji Maharaj. The Residential High School (Earlier Known as Tagore High School) was established in 1941. From this period onward development started at a faster pace.
